## AGREEMENT TO OUR LEGAL TERMS

If a Customer intends to host ITAR-regulated data, the Customer must explicitly notify ServLogi in writing prior to deployment to ensure the workload is provisioned exclusively within a U.S. Sovereign Cloud Zone. Upon such notification, ServLogi agrees to restrict logical and physical access to the underlying hardware exclusively to verified "U.S. Persons" as defined by 22 CFR § 120.15. [X].4 DFARS Cyber Incident Reporting and Forensics In the event of a cyber incident or data breach affecting an environment hosting CUI or CDI, the Customer bears the primary responsibility for reporting the incident to the Department of Defense (DoD) via the DIBNet portal within the mandated 72-hour window, as required by DFARS 252.204-7012. ServLogi agrees to provide reasonable commercial cooperation—including the preservation of infrastructure-level logs and virtual machine snapshots—to assist the Customer with their forensic investigation and DoD reporting obligations. [X].5 Shared Responsibility and Assessment Limitations While ServLogi maintains independent infrastructure security attestations (such as SOC 2 Type II or continuous monitoring protocols), the Customer acknowledges that ServLogi's compliance does not automatically confer compliance upon the Customer. The Customer is entirely responsible for passing their own third-party CMMC, DoD, or federal agency audits. ServLogi shall not be held liable for a Customer's failure to attain or maintain required defense sector certifications.
